

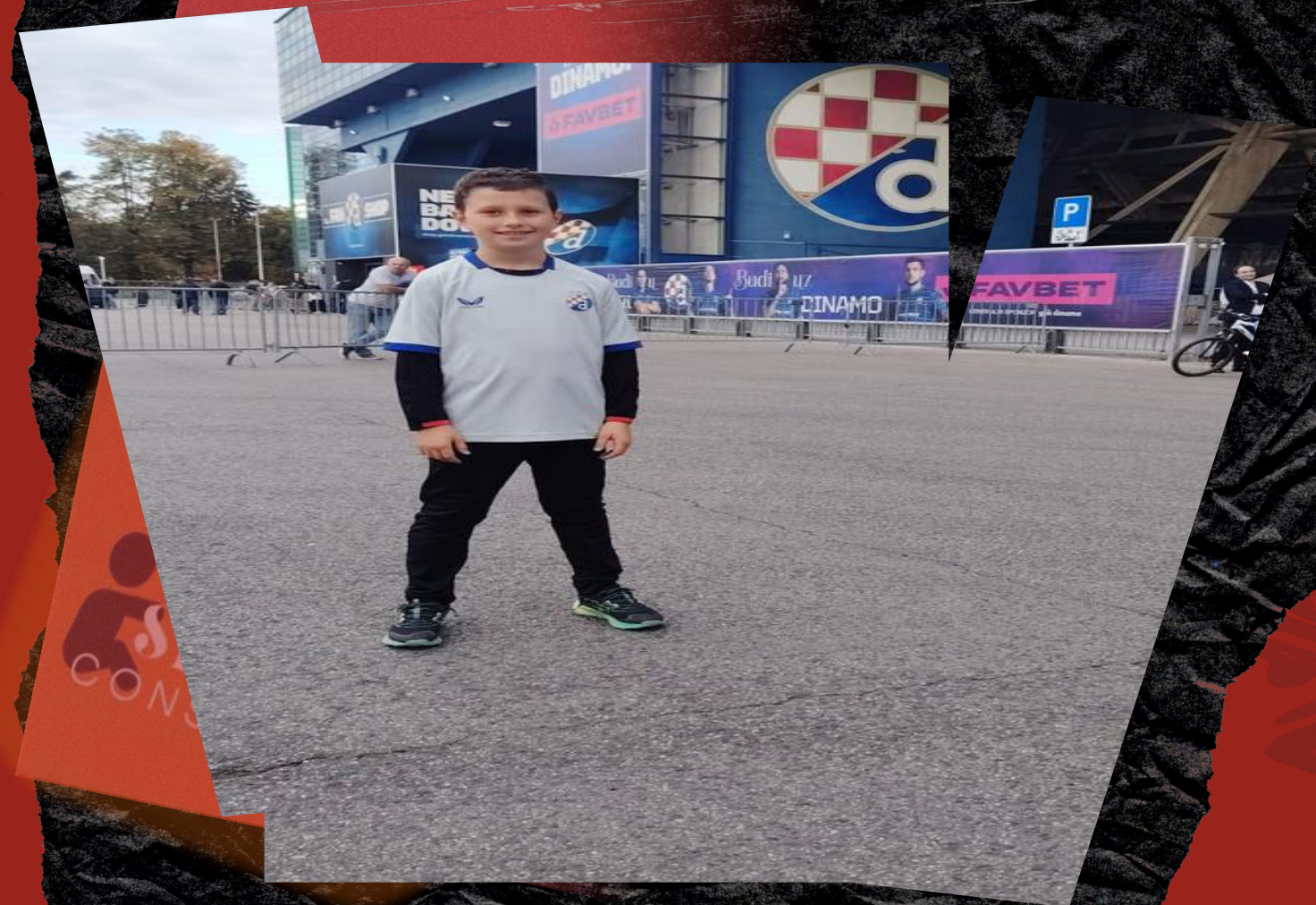

GENERAL COMMENT

Points (1-5)

TECHNICAL - Right-footed CB with advanced ball mastery for age, strong 1v1 defending, and above-average coordination/agility. Shows reliable short passing on both feet and composure on the ball. Long distribution and first touch on the non-dominant INSIDE still require work

TACTICAL - is a tactically intelligent defender with a natural sense of positioning and game reading. Continued work on passing decisions and timing when stepping out to press will enhance his overall tactical maturity.

CONDITIONING - Physical metrics indicate average acceleration/top speed for age, very good lower-body power (broad jump 165 cm), and average aerobic base.

PSYCHOLOGICAL - shows excellent emotional stability, confidence, and intrinsic motivation. He possesses early signs of leadership potential, which can be further developed through responsibility-based roles (e.g., organizing the back line, communication during matches).

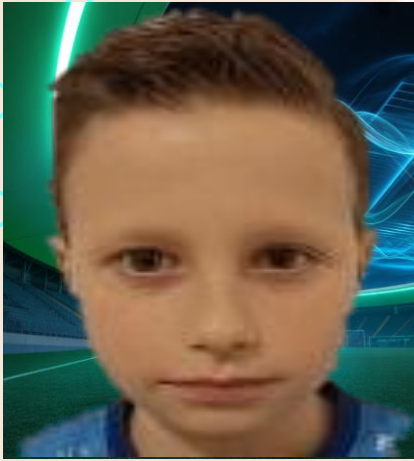

Technical Skills

Lucas shows a very solid **technical foundation** and ball control for his age. His first touch is clean and well-oriented, especially on his dominant foot, while his non-dominant foot has shown noticeable improvement.

- Demonstrates **accurate and well-timed short passing**, using controlled passes on the ground with good tempo and direction.
- Long passing** remains an area for development — needs to refine body positioning, follow-through, and contact point to achieve a more consistent and linear delivery.
- In **ball control and dribbling**, he appears composed and balanced, allowing him to progress the ball effectively from the back line.
- Shows solid ball-striking ability with both feet; dominant foot provides stability and power, while the non-dominant foot is already functional for short passes and finishing at close range.
- Under pressure, he uses a **quick first touch** and good body orientation toward open space, helping him maintain possession effectively.

Physical Characteristics

Lucas stands out for his **coordination and agility**, supported by test data. In the agility T-test, he achieved **15.44 s** on his dominant side — **best among his positional peers**.

- Speed:** consistent acceleration (10 m – 2.5 s; 20 m – 4.3 s), with good initial burst; can still improve maximal sprint phase and stride length.
- Explosiveness:** strong lower-body power shown through a **165 cm broad jump**, placing him above average for his age group.
- Endurance:** 6-min test (1030 m) indicates an average aerobic base, with room for improvement through steady-state and interval conditioning.
- Coordination:** above average – demonstrates excellent body control and quick adaptation during direction changes.
- Flexibility and stability:** adequate range of motion and good core stability.

Psychological Profile

Lucas displays **remarkable composure and focus** for his age. He plays with confidence, courage, and a strong competitive mindset.

- Demonstrates **high concentration** and rarely loses focus during games.
- Has a strong **winning mentality**, showing immediate recovery behavior after mistakes.
- Listens carefully to coaching feedback and applies it consistently — **disciplined and coachable**.
- In group settings, he is **positive and supportive**, often setting the tone for others through his effort and attitude.
- Under pressure, he remains calm and tries to find constructive solutions instead of clearing the ball blindly — an advanced trait for a young centre-back.

Right-footed CB with advanced ball mastery for age, strong 1v1 defending, and above-average coordination/agility. Shows reliable short passing on both feet and composure on the ball. Long distribution and first touch on the non-dominant INSIDE still require work. Physical metrics indicate average acceleration/top speed for age, very good lower-body power (broad jump 165 cm), and average aerobic base.

Final Recommendation

- Recommend for Trial: Player shows significant potential and should be brought in for a closer look.
- Continue to Monitor: Promising player with key areas to develop. Re-evaluate in 3-6 months.
- File for Future Reference: May have potential but not currently at the required level.
- Not Suitable: Does not meet the required standard for our academy.

Coach-Identified Areas of Development

Technically stable defender with good game understanding. Role: Right centre-back in 2-1-3 system – responsible for defending space and initiating build-up. Focus areas: ball control, short passing, reaction in duels, communication.	Regularly use both feet in play (70% of situations). - Increase passing accuracy and first touch control. - Improve physical strength and explosiveness over 10 m.	- Individual technical sessions (weak foot, heading technique). - Strength and core stability training. - Video feedback for positioning and decision-making.	

In Possession:

- Build from the back using short passes on the right side.
- Improve comfort when receiving under pressure.
- Use the weaker foot more frequently in passing and control.

Out of Possession:

- Quicker reaction to opponent's direction change
- Improve communication with goalkeeper and pivot.
- Step out from the defensive line at the right moment to maintain compactness.

Quick orientation after losing possession (5-second press rule).
- Upon regaining the ball, make the first forward pass.

Defensive Transitions - reactions to losing possession, counter-press regain or backward force in ≤5s in ≥50% of central regains.

Action Points

- 1 In build-up phase, seek central passing lines, use 2 touches, and include the weaker foot when possible.
- 2 In defence, anticipate passes through the lines—don't wait, react early.
- 3 3. After regaining possession, make the first forward pass within 3 seconds.

MDT Roles

- Strength & Conditioning Coach: speed and lower body strength (2x/week).
- Physiotherapist: hip and foot mobility, injury prevention.
- Performance Analyst: defensive block analysis and reaction tracking.
- Nutritionist: hydration and recovery nutrition education.

Player Pathway Map

- 0–6 weeks: Stabilize technical elements; daily weaker-foot practice.
- 6–12 weeks: Additional technical sessions (heading, 1v1 defending).
- 12–24 weeks: Competitive development and leadership within the defensive unit.
